Description about the event:

G.Rajesh addressed the students that unlike many other countries the registration of pharmacists does not occur at the national level.

In order to practice pharmacy the Person must be licensed or registered in the province or territory in which the Person will work.

Each province in Canada is responsible for issuing a license to practice pharmacy in their own province.

All provinces except Quebec require applicants trained outside of Canada to have the Pharmacy Examining Board of Canada Certificate of Qualification. This Certificate is a major requirement for licensing in each province, but the Certificate alone does not mean the Person have the right to practice.

In addition to the PEBC Certificate of Qualification, each province has additional licensing requirements. These may include practical experience, English or French language skills, and forensic examinations. The Person must contact the regulatory authority in the province the Person chooses to practice in to receive full information about their requirements.

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As a pharmacy graduate trained outside of Canada, the Person must follow the 2-step Evaluation Procedure of the Person documents before the Person can write the Qualifying Exam. Once the Person has favorably completed the two steps, the Person will then be eligible to take the Qualifying Exam.

If the Person is a foreign-trained pharmacist who has graduated from a degree program acceptable to the Board and has been registered continuously for a minimum of 10 years as a pharmacist in Canada and are currently registered in good standing as a pharmacist in Canada, the Person may apply directly for the Qualifying Examination. However, the Person must first have the Person qualification assessed to confirm the Person eligibility and must contact the PEBC office for further information.

Description about the event:

Maneesh addressed the students The Australian Pharmacy Examining Council assists overseas trained pharmacists to obtain registration in Australia and thus enable them to practice their profession in Australia.

If the Person live overseas and are a pharmacist with a qualification gained outside Australia and the Person intend to migrate and work in this profession in Australia, the Person should first contact the nearest Australian Embassy, High Commission or Consulate.

If the Person live in Australia and hold qualifications in pharmacy gained overseas the Person will need to apply directly to APEC for an assessment of the Person qualifications.

If the Person hold pharmacy qualifications gained in Australia and are intending to migrate to Australia as a pharmacist, the Person will need to apply to APEC for an assessment of the Person qualifications.

If the Person obtained the Person pharmacy qualifications in Australia and are intending to migrate to Australia the Person will need a formal skills assessment of the Person qualifications completed by APEC.

If the Person obtained the Person pharmacy degree and license to practice in the United Kingdom, Ireland and New Zealand the Person will be accepted for registration by all State and Territory pharmacy registering authorities. Conditions for registration will vary between the registering authorities, and the




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Person may need a short period of practical experience supervised by a pharmacist in Australia before the Person can be registered. If the Person are intending to migrate to Australia the Person will need a skills assessment completed by APEC but will not be required to complete the APEC examination process.

If the Person qualifications do not immediately meet the Australian requirements, there are two options.

The first is to complete an Australian pharmacy degree course at one of the Australian universities. The qualifications awarded by these institutions satisfy the formal academic requirements for registration by all State and Territory pharmacy registering authorities. If the Person enroll in an award course, the Person may gain credit for the Person overseas studies. Universities are self-governing and determine their own entry requirements for credit transfers. The Person will then need to complete a period of supervised practical training - conditions vary from jurisdiction to jurisdiction.

The second option is to undertake the examination process conducted by the Australian Pharmacy Examining Council (APEC) Inc. The Person will need to formally apply for an assessment to determine the Person eligibility to undertake the examination process.

Counseling is mandatory throughout the procedure and is provided for candidates living in Australia by members of APEC. The APEC examination procedure is only part of the total assessment by pharmacy registering authorities and the Person may have to meet other requirements. All pharmacy registering authorities reserve the right to impose additional requirements to those stipulated by APEC.

Persons may be eligible for migration after meeting both the English Language requirement and passing the Stage I Examination. If approved for migration at that point, they may continue the APEC examination process on arrival in Australia.

The satisfactory completion of the entire examination process is required before a candidate may apply for registration as a pharmacist with a relevant registering authority in Australia. In normal circumstances, it should take about 12 to 18 months to complete the overall process, providing applicants do not fail any part of the examination. Candidates have five years to complete the exam process. This 5 year period commences from the date of successful completion of the Stage I Examination.

Assessment procedure has six components:

- Eligibility Assessment
- English Language Requirement
- Stage I Examination
- Interview and counseling
- Supervised practice

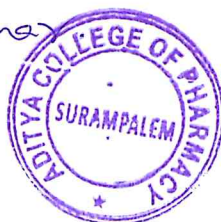
