- All lab courses are considered as skill development courses.
- In all B. Tech Programs under AR19 & AR20 regulation, Entrepreneurship Development and Incubation Course is offered as an elective course.

The members noted the same.

The Member Secretary presented that 15% of new courses were introduced for AR20 Regulation.

The Member Secretary informed that 5 Professional electives and 4 open elective courses are offered to the students. The students can opt any 2 electives through MOOCs.

Discussion: The Members advised that the students can opt for only 20% of the total courses through MOOCs to start with, which can later on be increased to 40%, based on the UGC guidelines. The members suggested that the BOS has to decide over the courses which can be opted through MOOCs in every semester.
