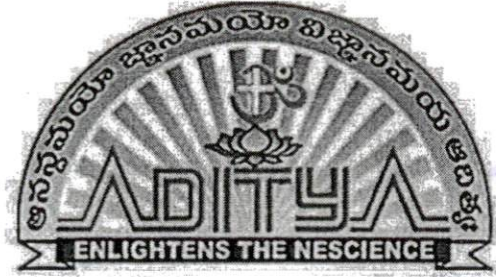

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1. Introduction

The Autonomous Examination is responsible for transparent, fair and Timely conduct of all examinations and result processing. The examinations conducted are:

- i. Semester End Examinations (Theory, Practical)
- ii. Sessional Examinations (Theory)

The Controller of Examinations (COE) will release the notifications with start and end dates for semester-end examinations. All students will apply for the examinations using the BET portal. The online activities carried out by the exam section are:

- Online form Fill-up by students
- BEE's Examination Tool (BETPLUS)
- Online payment of examination fees through the BETPLUS portal
- Approval of students for examination by the Department of COE
- Hall ticket download from BETPLUS portal by students.
- The examination schedule was entered into the online system so that the answer booklets are printed with student details along with the date and time.
- Print a day-wise attendance sheet for all examination schedules from the online system.
- The valuers carried out all Evaluations by accessing the Online Digital Valuation System (DVS) using the internet through separate login ID's and password for each valuer.
- Scrutiny was completed by using DVS.
- Other experienced valuers carried out the revaluation rather than the earlier ones.

- Scan the answer booklets for DVS or pack them for physical valuation
- Distribution of Appointment letter, id and password to valuers in case of DVS

- Distribution of Appointment letters to valuers from reputed colleges/universities for physical valuation.

OR

- Hand over of answer script bundles to COE of other reputed colleges/universities for physical valuation
- Scrutiny to all answer scripts.
- Print Day wise attendance sheet for all examinations and compare it with the results.
- Completion of Result processing
- Announcement of Results
- Notice for Script viewing, Revaluation application
- Collection of approved revaluation, script viewing application from students.
- Allocation of Answer scripts for revaluation
- Announcement of Revaluation Results
- Result Analysis as per Branch wise and subject wise.
- OBE (Objective Based Education) analysis

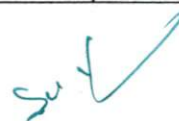
2. Student's performance in the Semester End Examinations:

3. Question Papers for Semester Examination

All question papers were made in four sets for each subject by experienced course experts from a reputed college/university. Course experts did scrutiny before 30 minutes of examinations. After scrutiny, question papers were reformatted and printed before 20 minutes of examination.

The answer booklets are distributed to invigilators of specific examination halls in the exam section. The question papers are given to observers, and they will distribute as per our instructions. After examination, the invigilator collected the answer booklets from students and submitted them to the exam section, and they were packed with seals.

Internal faculty members did all paper settings for the sessional examination for each subject. After notification of the sessional examination, internal faculties have submitted the question papers in the specified format.

4. Conduct of the Semester Examinations

This examination was conducted during the COVID 19 Second wave pandemic time. Before the semester examinations, we surveyed the students regarding the availability of the required infrastructure for the online examinations. From that survey, we know that only a few students have the proper facilities for appearing in online examinations. Hence, we changed the decision by allotting only 18 students in a room to write examinations by following all COVID rules strictly. During the examinations, the room allocation, seating plan, and examination rules were pasted on the entrance door of all examination halls and the notice boards on the institute premises. COE appointed observers to coordinate the following activities for the semester examinations in Academic Session 2020-21.

- Examination Duty Chart
- Room Allocation
- Seating Plan
- Invigilation Duty Chart
- Distribution of Question papers, answer scripts and attendance sheets to the invigilators
- Collection of Answer scripts, Attendance sheets and invigilator reports from the invigilators

5. Evaluation and Assessment

Odd Semester:

All appointments for examination of answer scripts were awarded to external faculty by handovering the stationary to the COE of another reputed college. Before the pandemic, COE appointed various experienced valuers from other reputed colleges to Aditya Spot Centre. The internal faculty completely did scrutiny.

Even Semester:

All appointments for examination of answer scripts were awarded to external faculty by providing login ID and passwords of DVS through online. COE collected mail Ids of valuers from other COE's of reputed colleges/universities. Scrutiny was completed automated by using DVS.

Data in the excel files were transferred to the BET PLUS server for result processing, and the internal marks were directly uploaded into BET PLUS. The tabulation and Result processing were automated. Subjects like drawing on sheets are evaluated physically, and both physical and online valuations are merged for result processing.

6. Result Announcement:

After the meeting with Results Committee, results are generated with the grafting needed for Autonomous Exam Portal. After the online announcement of the result, notification for revaluation was given by COE, and result analysis was done with a checklist & T-Sheet.


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7. Grievances Reported by students

The notification was given after the announcement of results and 6 days for every examination. The application procedure is online, and the valuation process is also online.

8. Automation of Examination System

The following examination activities were fully automated

1. Examination Forms fill up by students using the online portal
2. Attendance approval from HOD was introduced, which is automatically approved based on their class attendance.
3. Students can submit examination fees.
4. Students can download the hall ticket from the examination portal
5. A list of students appearing in the examination is prepared automatically
6. The examination schedule was entered into the online system to be displayed wherever necessary (Hallticket, Booklets, Stationary).
7. Print a day-wise attendance sheet for all examination schedules from the online system.
8. The examiners carried out online Evaluation by accessing the DVS system using the internet through separate login ID's for each examiner.
9. Scrutiny was completely automated using the DVS for the online evaluation system.

10. The different valutors who have not been valuated earlier carried out a re-evaluation.
11. Internal marks were uploaded in the BET PLUS.
12. Result Announcement and result verification through software.
13. Grafting was done as per the recommendations given by the examination committee.
14. Students appeared in the semester examination with strict COVID Precautions.


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
