Staff is sensitized on the following aspects related to code of conduct of the institute by the principal:


- All the teaching staff should teach lessons through proper lesson plan according to their course.

Students are sensitized on the following aspects related to code of conduct of the institute by the principal:


- Students should be regular to the college and be active in college activities to enhance their knowledge day by day.

Closing remarks:


