The Members unanimously resolved approving the proposal.

The members commented that the AIML and Data Science are hot pack courses having industry orientation and needs industry interaction. The members instructed that faculty

strength should be increased and more faculty members are to be recruited as per the increased intake.

Agenda: 13.5.3 Details of placements for the academic year 2023-24.

The Member Secretary presented that 54% of eligible students are placed as of now in the A.Y 2023-24 with highest and average packages of 29.54 LPA and 3.68 LPA respectively and there are 10 International Placement offers with a package of more than 25 LPA.

The Member Secretary also presented the placement details of 2023 passed out students (Batch 2019-23) including On-campus offers, off-campus offers, students who opted for higher studies and students who opted for entrepreneurship.

The members noted the same and appreciated the Management and Principal for having International Placements. The members advised to present how internships are helping the students in placements. The members enquired about the reasons for poor placements in a few departments and suggested including skill- oriented certification programmes.

Agenda: 13.6.1.1 Paper Publications.

The Member Secretary presented that an amount of Rs. 21.95 Lakhs was disbursed to faculty and students as incentives for publications in Journals, Conferences, Books / Chapters, Patents and innovative projects. The Member Secretary further informed that 142 papers were published by the faculty in Journals/Conferences.

The members noted the Paper publications done by faculty and advised the following.

- > Not to include conference publications in the total publications.
- ➤ Each HOD need to prepare a suggestive list of international journals, where the faculty should publish papers. This should be circulated to all faculty and encourage them to publish in these journals.
- Incentives may be given for publications in Q1 or Q2 Journals only.
- > Monitor the h-index of faculty every year and if required, the faculty can be counselled.

Agenda: 13.6.1.2 Consultancy activities

The Member Secretary presented that the institution has generated a fund of Rs. 5,10,900/- by consultancy activities and by conducting various online examinations.

The members noted the same. The members suggested to carry out consultancy in the areas of project management, site works, quality certification and training programs etc.

Agenda: 13.6.1.3 Patents Published / Granted

The Member Secretary presented the details of 77 patents published by the faculty members and 8 patents that were granted.

The members noted the same and appreciated the faculty members, who were granted patents. The members advised to host a short video on the granted patent in the Institute website to enable the industries/NGOs for technology transfer.

The Member Secretary presented that the institution procured major equipment worth of Rs. 25,53,604/- during the A. Y. 2023-24.

The members noted the same.

The Member Secretary presented that the library has 12,591 Titles and 86,614 Volumes of books worth Rs. 261.66 lakhs. The library has subscribed to 90 National and 70 International Journals. The library incurred an expenditure of Rs. 33.18 lakhs during the A. Y. 2023-24.

The members noted the same and advised mentioning the average number of visitors and recording the average time spent by users in the library.

Agenda: 13.6.3.1 Details of the staff who joined / left the college from the date of previous meeting

The Member Secretary presented the details of 21 faculty members who have joined the institution and 16 faculty members who have left the institution from the date of previous meeting.

The members noted the same. The members advised the management to see that faculty retention is increased.

The members noted the same and appreciated the management for sanctioning scholarships to the students.

The Member Secretary presented that 98-99% of students are having attendance >75%, 34 students were detained and 50 students are being condoned during the A.Y 2023-24.

The members noted the same. The Members appreciated the faculty as 98-99% of students have attendance >75%. The members also appreciated the sincerity of teachers for taking regular classes and for motivating the students to attend all classes without fail.

The Member Secretary presented that 23 students were readmitted in the A.Y 2023-24.

The members noted the same.

The Member Secretary presented that 29 students in Extra-curricular activities and 44 students in Co-curricular activities won prizes during A.Y 2023-24.

The members noted the same and appreciated the students who have won prizes in extracurricular / co-curricular activities and opined that it would be a great honor for the students to receive appreciation from the Academic Council. The members appreciated Mr. P. Sathwik, ECE student who won Gold Medal in NASA competition. The members suggested the Management to sponsor Mr. Sathwik for his higher studies and also said that they would like to support Mr. Sathwik if he requires, with a Recommendation Letter for his higher education abroad.

- > To appoint visiting faculty, adjunct faculty from leading Indian and foreign universities.
- Making a policy in future for promotions and fresh recruitment with a minimum hindex, a minimum number of citations, a minimum consultancy amounts etc. in addition to academic qualifications.
- > Introducing incentive positions such as Professor (Higher Academic Grade), Institute Professor etc. in future.
