(Reduce -Reuse-Recycle)

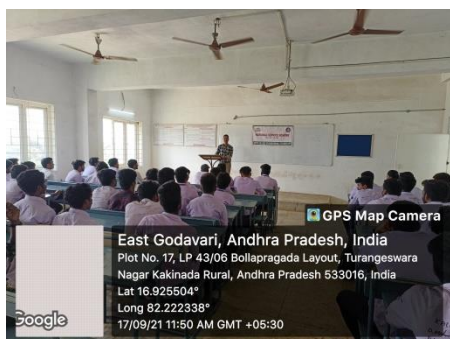

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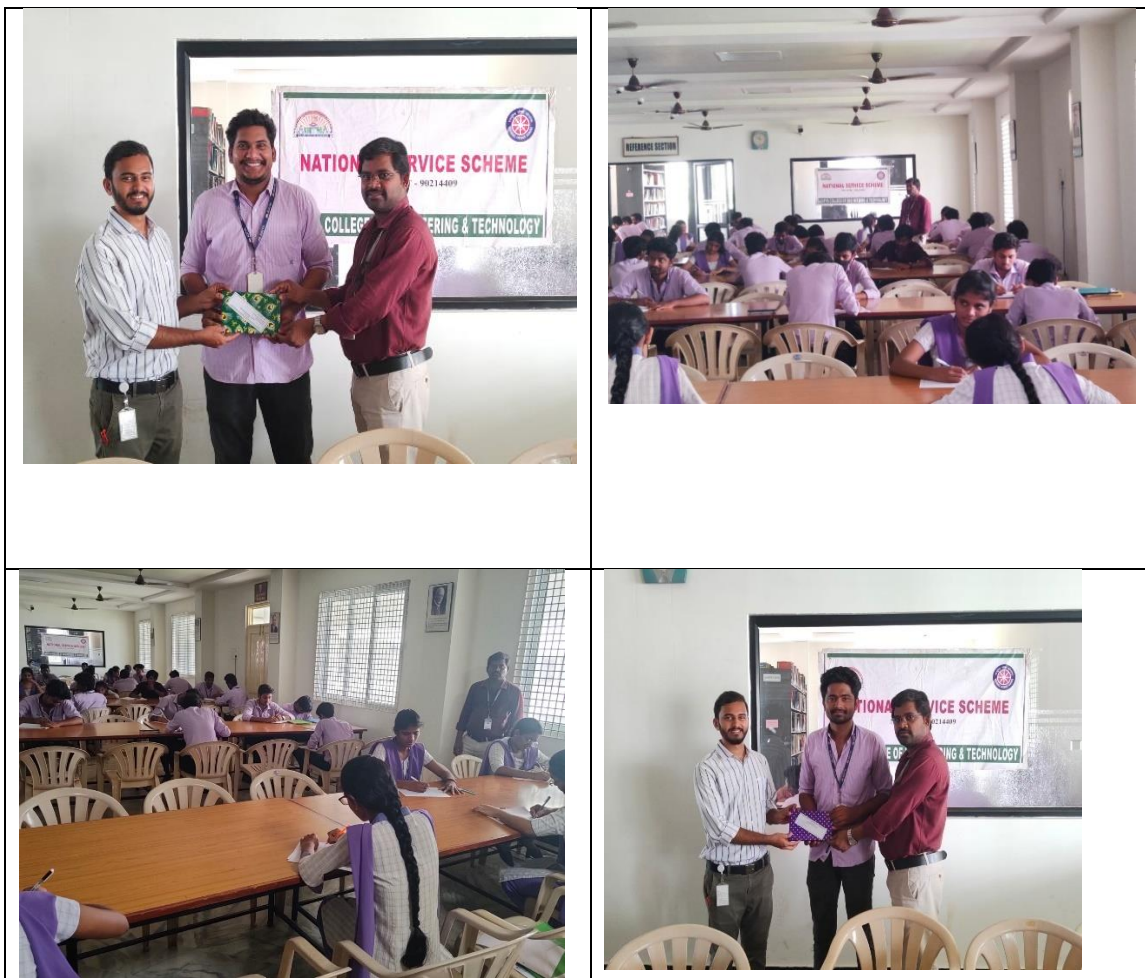
Report on Essay Writing On the Occasion of National Unity Day

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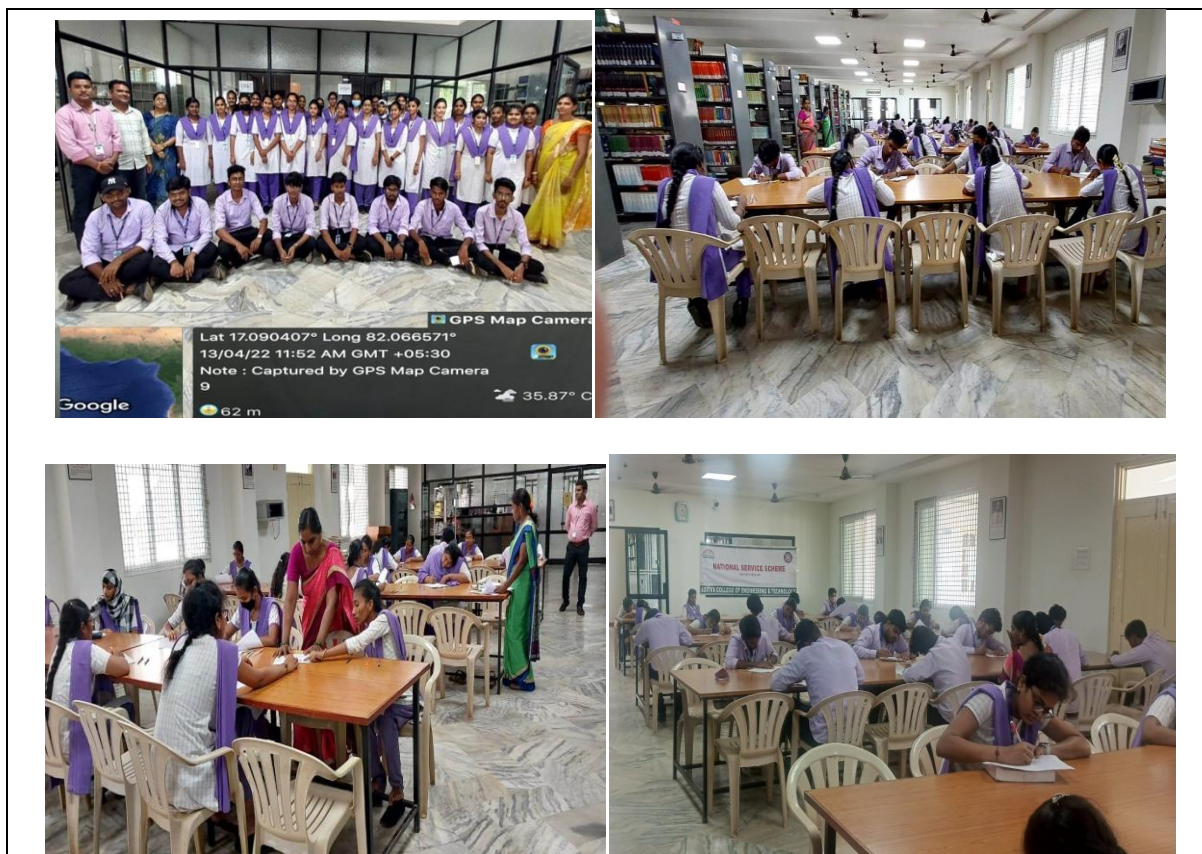
Report on Essay Writing On “Eassy Writing of Equal Opportunity”
